



Purpose

To financially support students in educational, sporting and cultural endeavours.

Overview

Some families may struggle to pay for excursions, camps, retreats, sporting events, and other school approved activities.

The College will consider sponsoring students by request.

Scope

Saint Francis Xavier College (SFX) endeavours to support students who:

- represent the ACT and or Australia in sport
- engage in charitable work which may include Youth Ministry programs or volunteering
- require assistance to be able to participate in school excursions, camps, retreats and other school approved activities
- participation in activities that have the potential to provide a positive benefit for the student and the school community
- participate in cultural or educational opportunities at elite or extension level.

Policy Statement

The College will endeavour to support students to participate in College approved activities where families who may be in a financially disadvantaged position.

Student Sponsorship Application Form may be completed and submitted to the Principal of SFX by the student, parent/carer or on recommendation from a staff member or member of the community.

Each application will be considered on its merit by the College Executive. The decision of the College Executive is final.

As a guide, students may be granted \$100 sponsorship for ACT selection and \$250 for selection to represent Australia. Requests for other activities will be given due consideration in line with these levels of participation and allocated grants.

The Principal of SFX will respond in writing to the applicant regarding the outcome of their application within two school weeks of receiving the application.
