In Semester Two, Year 10 students are invited to attend Learning Commons mini workshop presentations led by external professionals for the purpose of providing information on career pathways. Each week will feature a different professional from a variety of industries and tertiary institutions highlighting how students can access specific future pathway options. The presentations are carefully designed to help inform different year groups and their different stages of their future pathways journey.

Each week, prior to each presentation there will be a QR code for students to sign up to, in addition to this they require your permission to attend – the QR code will be located in the Coordinator's corridor and the Resource Centre.
