

Home Supported BYOD Specifications

If you are purchasing a laptop on your own through the SFX Home Supported BYOD option, the device must meet the following hardware and functionality requirements.

Form factor	Laptop: Windows platform ONLY Tablets or phones are not acceptable devices for use under BYOD	
Operating system	Microsoft Windows 11 <u>except</u> Windows S (not compatible) Windows 11 recommended	
Wireless capability	At least 5Ghz WiFi (802.11an or 802.11ac - an 'a' is mandatory) This may be advertised as Dual Band Wireless, 802.11abgn, 802.11 agn, 802.11ac or Gigabit Wireless. Note: Devices marketed only as 802.11bgn do NOT support the required standard.	
	Recommended: We operate the latest WiFi-6 capable network. Look for a WiFi-6 capable device, this can be marketed with the following symbols:	
Battery life	Advertised battery life of at least six hours (8–10 hours recommended)	
СРИ	Batteries degrade over time, old devices from home might not be sufficient.	
	Minimum: 12 th Generation Celeron (N Series), Intel Core i3, or AMD RYZEN 3 Recommended: Intel Core i5 or AMD RYZEN 5	
	Recommended for Senior Adobe Suite: Quad core i7 or higher	
	Minimum: 8 Gigabytes	
Memory / RAM	Recommended: 16 Gigabytes	
	Recommended for Senior Adobe Suite: 16+ Gigabytes	
Hard drive	Minimum: 128 Gigabytes	
	Recommended: 256GB SSD	
	Recommended for Senior Adobe Suite: 512GB SSD	
USB	At least 1 x 2.0 USB port	
Display	Minimum: 1280 x 800 or 1366 x 768 resolution	
	Recommended: 1600 x 900 resolution or higher	
Text input device	Keyboard and trackpad	
Video	Inbuilt video card with 512 megabytes or more of memory	
Multimedia device	Webcam with inbuilt microphone	
Optional features	Memory card reader	

<u>Take special note of the Wireless compatibility requirements.</u> This is the most difficult requirement to verify yourself. If you are unsure, consider purchasing a device through the College's Vendor Portal.
